Professional Standards Report 2025

The Kernersville Police Department promptly and thoroughly investigates all allegations of misconduct involving its personnel, regardless of the source of the complaint. Each internal investigation is conducted in a fair, objective, and impartial manner. A single investigation may involve multiple complainants and may address multiple alleged violations of departmental rules, regulations, policies, or procedures. In 2025, the Department investigated or reviewed five (5) incidents. Of these, three (3) were external citizen complaints, and two (2) were internal matters. All five (5) cases were ultimately closed as unfounded.

Disposition Definitions

Unfounded: The allegation is false, or there is insufficient evidence to support the allegation.

Not Sustained: There is insufficient evidence to either prove or disprove the allegation.

Exonerated: The incident complained of occurred, but was lawful and proper.

Sustained: The allegation is supported by sufficient evidence to indicate that the allegation is true.
